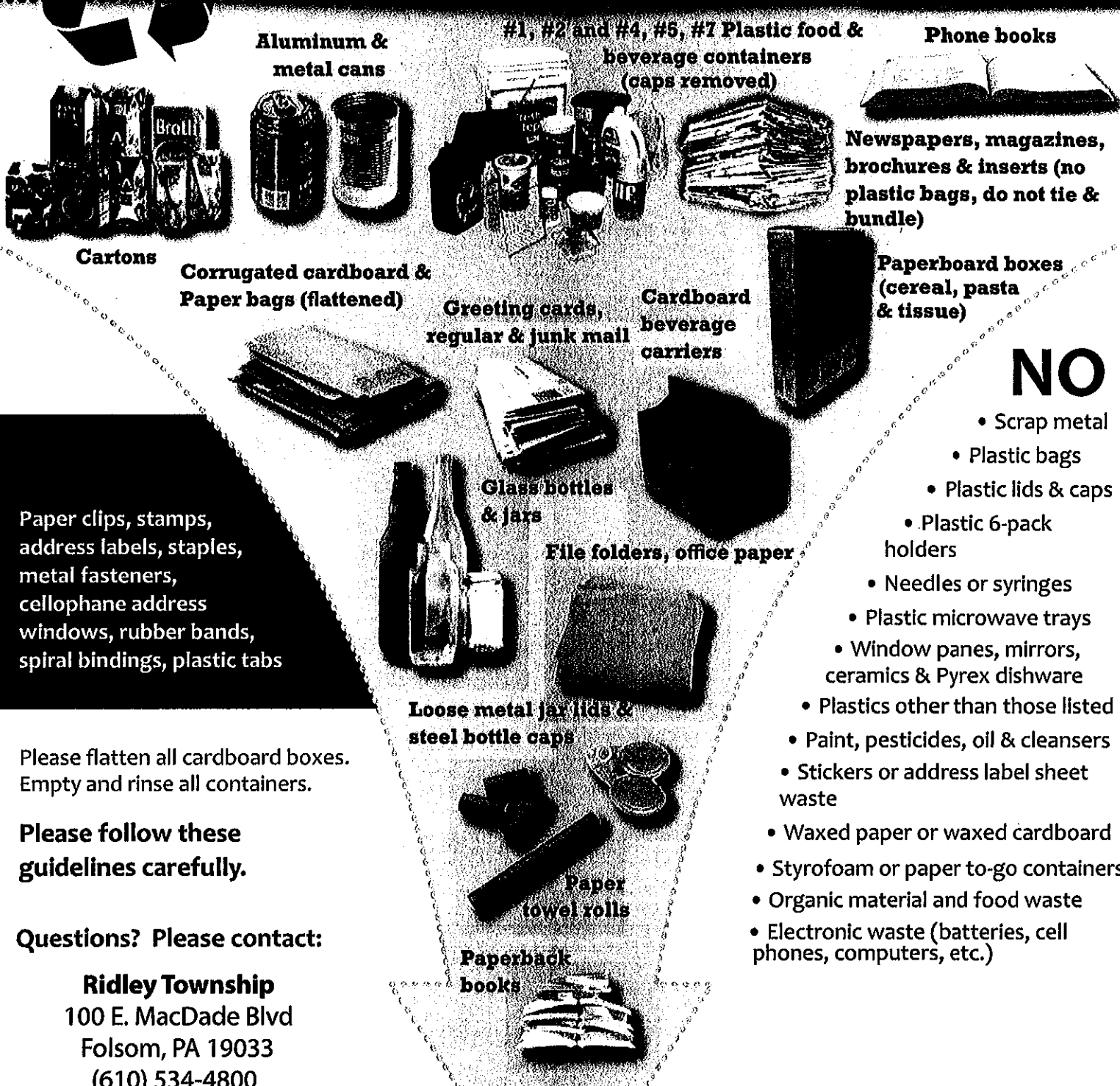


# Residential Guide to Zero-Sort Recycling



**Aluminum & metal cans**

**#1, #2 and #4, #5, #7 Plastic food & beverage containers (caps removed)**

**Phone books**

**Newspapers, magazines, brochures & inserts (no plastic bags, do not tie & bundle)**

**Cartons**

**Corrugated cardboard & Paper bags (flattened)**

**Greeting cards, regular & junk mail**

**Cardboard beverage carriers**

**Paperboard boxes (cereal, pasta & tissue)**

**Glass bottles & jars**

**File folders, office paper**

**Loose metal jar lids & steel bottle caps**

**Paper towel rolls**

**Paperback books**

Paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, metal fasteners, cellophane address windows, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs

Please flatten all cardboard boxes. Empty and rinse all containers.

### WEDNESDAY RECYCLING DAY IS COMING TO RIDLEY!

*Recycling is good for the earth and good for your purse!*



Did you know that only 27% of Ridley Township residents currently recycle?



Did you know that in March, 2011 the Township received **\$42.55 per ton** for recycling material, which is the highest paid to date as the market fluctuates?

For the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2011, the following was recorded:

Trash Collected Curbside (tons)	3,120.96	Disposal Fee Charged to Township	\$73,186.32
Recycling Collected Curbside (tons)	507.80	Fee Received from Recycling Center	\$17,793.00

Imagine if this was reversed! **If you have trash, you have recycling.** If recycling tonnage increases, trash tonnage would decrease and the cost of disposing would drop, thus saving money.

We all need to do our part and by doing so, help the environment and help keep taxes down.

**Let's set a goal....let's see if we can increase recycling participation to 100%!**

Beginning JULY 6, 2011, recycling collection for all areas of Ridley Township will be on WEDNESDAY ONLY and continue every Wednesday thereafter.

Trash days will remain the same.
